The balance must be paid in full by 10th January 2009. Payment can be made online by credit card, by cheque (made payable to Base Camp International Ltd) or by electronic transfer.

## Booking Conditions

### 1 Booking Confirmation

1.1 All bookings are made with Base Camp Group (hereafter known as BCG), which is a trading name of Base Camp International Ltd.

1.2 This booking will become the binding contract ("the Contract") between BCG and you ("the Parties") only when BCG acknowledges the receipt of the Booking Form and non-refundable registration fee as indicated in clause 2.1 below. The Contract will be subject to these Booking Conditions (the "Conditions") and will be governed and construed in accordance with English Law.

### 2 Payment Schedules

2.1 A non-refundable registration fee of £200 per person must be made with each booking. Confirmation of your booking will then be sent by return of post outlining the payment schedules.

2.2 The final invoice for the outstanding balance due must be paid no later than 10<sup>th</sup> January 2009.

2.3 As all payments are non-refundable BCG advises that travel insurance is taken out with this booking and is included in all BCG Packages.

### 3 Prices

3.1 BCG reserves the right to impose surcharges in respect to cost increases related to fuel, currency or UK or foreign government action. BCG will absorb an increase equivalent to 2 % of the course or accommodation price. If the surcharge exceeds 10 % of the holiday price, you have the right to cancel and receive a full refund of invoices paid, less any amendment or insurance charges paid.

3.2 No refunds shall be given if currency rates improve.

3.3 Value added tax had been included in the prices to comply with HM Custom and Excise regulations in force as at 1st October 1998.

### 4 Cancellation By BCG

4.1 BCG reserves the right to cancel the mashup\* Skicamp. In the highly unlikely event of cancellation, you will have the choice of accepting an alternative arrangement or a full refund of all invoices paid. BCG will try to ensure that any alternative arrangements offered are of at least equivalent standard to those originally booked.

## **5 Cancellation By You**

5.1 If you wish to cancel the mashup\* Skicamp or leave prematurely, all registration fees and payments are non-refundable.

## **6 Limitation Of Liability**

6.1 Whilst we (BCG) take all reasonable precautions to prevent accidents or injury, you acknowledge and agree that some of the activities you participate in during the mashup\* Skicamp carry a risk of accident and injury.

6.2 We accept responsibility for death or bodily injury caused by our negligence or that of our employees, agents, contractors or suppliers when acting in the course of their employment or in accordance with our instructions.

6.3 Except as provided in clauses 4 and 5 below, we accept responsibility for any loss or damage resulting from our failure to perform, or improper performance of, the services we have agreed to provide you.

6.4 Subject always to clauses 2 and 3 above, we do not accept responsibility for any loss or damage you suffer where any failure to perform, or improper performance, is not due to our negligence or that of our employees, agents, contractors or suppliers including but not limited to where any such failure or improper performance is attributable, in whole or in part, to:

6.4.1 you or any member of your party

6.4.2 any third party unconnected with the provision of the services we have agreed to provide to you, and is not reasonably foreseeable or unavoidable; or

6.4.3 any circumstances beyond our reasonable control and which could not have been foreseen or avoided even if all due care had been exercised, including but not limited to war or threat of war, riot, civil unrest or insurrection, strike, lockout or other industrial action, act of terrorism, act of God, fire, flood or other adverse weather conditions.

6.5 Subject only to the limitation of liability in clause 6.6 below, our liability to you for any loss or damage which you may suffer (other than death or bodily injury under clause 6.1 above and for which our liability will be unlimited), whether as a result of our failure to perform, or the improper performance of, the services we have agreed to provide to you or otherwise, is limited to £2 000 000 for all claims arising from a single event.

6.6 Our liability to you for the non-performance or improper performance by any air, sea or rail carrier or any hotelier for any services to be provided by them as part of the m

the amount you can validly recover against such carrier or hotelier:

6.6.1 in accordance with any applicable domestic law or the laws of England, for claims other than death or bodily injury arising out of travel, carriage or accommodation within the United Kingdom or which is otherwise not international; and

6.6.2 in accordance with any international convention (if any) governing such service, for all claims arising out of any other travel, carriage or accommodation.

6.7 Except as expressly stated above, we do not accept liability for any claim, whether arising in contract, tort (including negligence) or otherwise, for any consequential, indirect or special loss or damage however arising.

6.8 Nothing in these booking conditions affects your statutory rights as a consumer.

6.9 Where your loss or damage is due to the acts of our agents, suppliers or contractors, our acceptance of liability is subject to you assigning to us any rights you may have against them and to your co-operating with us fully in any legal action we may take against them.

6.10 We accept responsibility for ensuring the mashup\* Skicamp is supplied as described in our brochure. If it fails to comply, in whole or in part, with any such description, we will pay you appropriate compensation (compensation payable will depend on nature and extent of misdescription). Certain statements may go out of date from time-to-time so clients wishing to place specific reliance on any statement within the brochure or any other documentation, which was believed to be correct at the time of publication, should seek written confirmation of that statement before accepting the offer of a place, or on immediate receipt of documentation.

## **8 Complaints**
